All shops stock different brands and charge different prices so please do take some time to calculate how much your shopping costs where you shop. You might find some of these items are better value / more expensive depending nwhere you buy them and what brand you buy.

Waste is a huge issue for many households in Ireland, we are told that the average family will throw out up to €700 worth of food per year. Try to avoid having any waste to save yourself money and ensure that all items you buy are used. This is especially relevant for perishable goods e.g. a loaf of bread will only last a few days, so if you buy one use it in as many meals as you can – eg toast for breakfast and sandwiches for lunch.
