SVP is committed to safeguarding children by working under the guidance of our national safeguarding policies and procedures. Our members, non-member volunteers and staff are committed to creating a safe environment for children and young people to grow and develop.

Each SVP Children's Activity or Service will conduct a specific written risk assessment and child safeguarding statement in line with Children First Act 2015, Protection for Persons Reporting Child Abuse Act 1998, NVB Act 2012 and 2016, Children First Guidance 2017 and Tusla Guidance on Developing a Child Safeguarding Statement.

Service Description: A Resource Centre providing activities for children in direct provision, an intergenerational programme and a homework club as well as older people's service, lunch and social club, training, classes, men's group, failte Isteach (conversational english), support to asylum seekers with interviews.

The written risk assessment indicates the areas of potential harm, the likelihood of harm occurring, and lists the required policy, guidance, process and practice required to alleviate the risks. Risks are identified in the following categories:

- Risk of harm of a child by a member of staff, volunteer or peer
- Risk of harm of a child by a visitor to the service
- Risk of harm of a child on outings by a member of staff/volunteer/stranger/peer
- Risk of harm of unauthorised collection of children from Homework Club
- Risk of harm of Information on service and how it is operated not given to Parents
- Risk of harm from bullying of a child by a member of staff/volunteer/peer
- Risk of harm of a child from unauthorised photography
- Risk of harm of a child from online abuse through social media or internet access
- Reporting concerns
- Infections and pandemics
